## Thank You RFK

For decades, Robert F. Kennedy Jr. has fought to shield our kids from reckless pharmaceutical power. These photos will send a clear, parent-powered message across the country: **families stand united behind him.**

### Three Simple Steps:

1) Child makes the sign	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>8½x11 or larger, thick paper or cardboard, child-safe markers or paint.</li> <li>Include a heart, smiley, or whatever your child enjoys drawing.</li> </ul>
2) Parent takes the photo	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Natural lighting is best, no shadows on the sign or eyes.</li> <li>Child holds sign chest-height; parent kneels or stands close.</li> </ul>
3) Parent posts & tags	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Facebook / Instagram / X</li> <li>Tag any or all (@SecKennedy; @robertfkennedyjr)</li> <li>Use the hashtag #ThankYouRFK</li> </ul>
