SECTION 3 – IMPORTANT INFORMATION (PLEASE READ)

I have read the "statement of exemption regarding COVID-19 vaccination exemption for residence" (hereinafter "*exemption form*"), from the _____ College/University,

requires that I complete and read the information on its *exemption form*. I confirm that I have read the exemption form in its entirety. However, I cannot provide the information required as it is illegal and requires me to forfeit and relinquish my legal rights without lawful authority or justification. I also cannot swear or affirm that the information in the *exemption form* is accurate or true, as I know it to be inaccurate and false.

The requirement for all students living in campus residence to be "fully vaccinated against COVID-19" is unlawful. (See attached letter to College/University president attached.)

RISKS OF NOT BEING VACCINATED:

There is no evidence that the "vaccines" against COVID-19 prevent infection or transmission, or decrease death. The trials were only designed to address the reduction of symptomatic disease. New guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) on July 27th 2021 states that recent studies show that "vaccinated" individuals who become infected with SARS-CoV-2 have just as much viral load as the "unvaccinated", making it possible for them to spread the virus to others. Therefore, an "unvaccinated" student is not more likely to be exposed to the COVID-19 virus than "vaccinated" students living in a group setting where the COVID-19 virus may be transmitted more easily, or in any other setting for that matter.

COVID-19 rarely results in serious illness. University aged students are at particularly low risk of harm from SARS-CoV-2 infection. According to world-leading epidemiologist John Ioannidis, the infection fatality rate of COVID-19 is in the order of 0.15% to 0.2% across all age groups, with a very strong bias towards old people, particularly those with co-morbidities. This rate does not exceed the range commonly observed with influenza and is actually less fatal in the young and healthy than influenza.

There are inherent risks to submitting to COVID-19 "vaccines", which are still experimental and have alarming documented adverse effects. COVID-19 "vaccines" may sensitize recipients to more severe disease than if they were not "vaccinated". As of July 16, 2021, data released by the CDC Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System (VAERS) includes 491,217 injuries of which 11,405 are deaths. Data for University student shows 50 reported deaths, 650 cases of myocarditis/pericarditis, 88 heart attacks and 281 reports of blood clotting disorders. Therefore, consent must be informed and not coerced.

1. An exemption is not required from unlawful action as the requirement itself is invalid.
2. Completing an *exemption form* is also unlawful as the information requested in answer to the questions asked would cause a breach of privacy and I do not provide consent as it is not a true choice or voluntarily given. The personal and private health information requested in the *exemption form* is not required or necessary to the stated purpose. The requirement to provide personal and protected health information is being requested as a condition to live in campus residence which is necessary for me to attend/access education.
3. The information regarding the “risks of not being vaccinated” on the *exemption form* are inaccurate and false. Providing a signature on the *exemption form* would be against my conscience and constitute perjury.

As per Section 366 of the Criminal Code, it is an offence to make a false document, knowing it to be false, with intent that a person should be induced, by the belief that it is genuine, to do or to refrain from doing anything.
